About ScubaJam Virginia...

What is ScubaJam?

ScubaJam Virginia is designed to provide a great scuba diving experience boys and girls, ages 11-20. This weekend long event is based around fun diving activities in buddy pairs with land based demonstrations, camping and other social activities for young, certified divers to share with friends. The event was created by interested divers representing dive shops and various BSA Troops and Venturing Crews in Virginia as well as internationally recognized scuba training operations.

Who can participate in ScubaJam?

ScubaJam is designed for certified scuba divers, boys and girls, ages 11-20 who are members of organized youth groups like BSA, GSA and Venture Crews; however, any youth group can participate.

Registration

Registration is accepted for groups of 6 or more including at least 1 adult group leader. There is no maximum to how many can register in one group. Each group must have a certified dive professional directly supervising all diving events. Registration will soon be available online at our website www.scubajam-va.org.

What do I get?

All participants receive a commemorative T-shirt, entry to the quarry with diving/swimming privileges and camping from Friday thru Monday afternoon. Diver participants receive unlimited air fills for the weekend. In addition Youth participants (under age 20) receive a gift bag, entry to all raffles and events while Adult participants receive a commemorative hat.

Awards and Prizes

All participants get a bag full of great promos donated by dive training agencies, dive equipment manufacturers, ScubaJam T-shirt and entry into a raffle.

In 2011, the raffle grand prize was a trip on Blackbeards Cruise (www.blackbeards-cruises.org). Other prizes included mask

and snorkel sets, diving accessories, and Continuing Diver Education Certificates. These certificates can be redeemed for continuing education courses in scuba diving at any dive shop in the world! ScubaJam Virginia gave away a total of \$1250 in Certificates to participants in 2011 as raffle prizes and awards to divers who demonstrated excellent diving and safety skills.

What if I am not a Certified Scuba Diver?

This event is geared towards certified divers and you'll want to be certified to participate in all the fun events. So, contact your local dive shop and get certified! If you need help finding one, see the list on the back page or contact us and we'll be glad to help.

Do I have to be in BSA or GS-USA?

Participation is open to any registered youth group such as Venturing Crews, 4-H, Church groups, etc. Each group must adhere to the by-laws of their organization. If you do not belong to a registered youth group, contact your local dive shop. For additional information, please contact us at info@scubajam-va.org.

Can I register by myself?

All events are scheduled around group participation. If you are not part of a group or have a group of less than 6 youth, contact your local dive shop or one of the sponsoring dive shops. They will likely know who is participating. Most Troops and Crews will be happy to allow you to join for this single event and Scouts can dually register at no additional charge.

How do I register my group?

We are working towards an online registration system this year for your convenience. Registration will be available on our website at www.scubajam-va.org. If you prefer to speak to someone regarding registration, please contact us at info@scubajam-va.org.

What are the benefits of early registration?

Groups can register early with a non-refundable deposit of \$250 and receive preference to camp site selection and may be able to have a private shelter. Groups that register and pay for at least 6 participants can add to their group up to the date of the event at preregistration prices. All monies received by ScubaJam become non-refundable after 7/31/12.

What if my group doesn't have a certified dive professional?

We encourage you to contact your local Dive Shop to see if they can provide you with a dive professional. Alternatively, contact one of the sponsoring dive shops or contact us at info@scubajam-va.org. We know of a lot of people who would love to help your group enjoy this event.
